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### RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 11-TM-05

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the communities of Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

**WHEREAS**, Te-Moak Tribal Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-01 as amended by Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-03 provides for the issuing of liquor licenses; and


**WHEREAS**, in accordance to the Te-Moak Liquor Ordinance 82-ORD-TM-03, section 1, paragraph (d) No such License shall be issued without the approval of the local governing body of the Colony or Reservation of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Nevada, upon the territory of which the proposed alcoholic beverage business is seeking to be licensed; and

**WHEREAS**, at a duly held meeting of the Elko Band Council on March 30, 2011 Resolution #2011-EBC-06 was adopted to approve a Liquor License for Jeff Watson from Gladiator Challenger for May7, 2011 to be held at the Elko Colony Gymnasium; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council hereby approves a for Gladiator Challenger with a administrative fee charge of \$250.00 to be made payable to the Te-Moak Tribe for processing as per Te-Moak Resolution #10-TM-19 adopted on July 7, 2010.

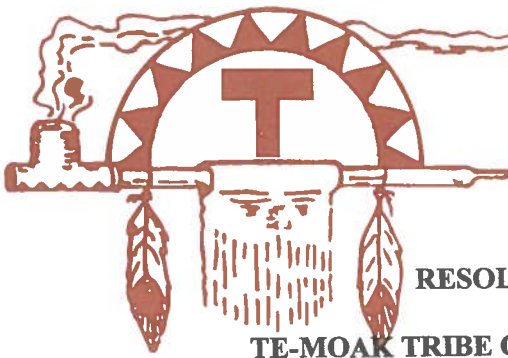

RESOLUTION NO: 11-TM-04

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA; THAT**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well being of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

**WHEREAS**, as per the Te-Moak Constitution Article 9, Section 3(d) - To charter and regulate independent organizations, subordinate organizations, committees, and boards of officials of the Tribe; and to delegate powers as appropriate, retaining the right to supervise and to rescind delegated powers; and

**WHEREAS**, the South Fork Band Council by Resolution #11-SF-06 accepted the resignation of Brandon Reynolds who voluntarily removed himself as a representative of the Te-Moak Council and Te-Moak Housing Board by submitting a letter of resignation.


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, this Resolution replaces Brandon Reynolds and recognizes Ronnie Woods as the official representative for the Te-Moak Tribal Council and Housing Board Representative.
